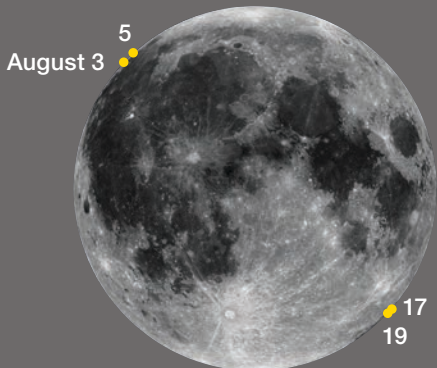


The Moon • August 2018
