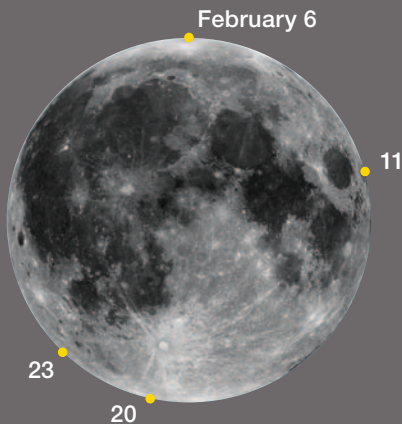


The Moon • February 2017
