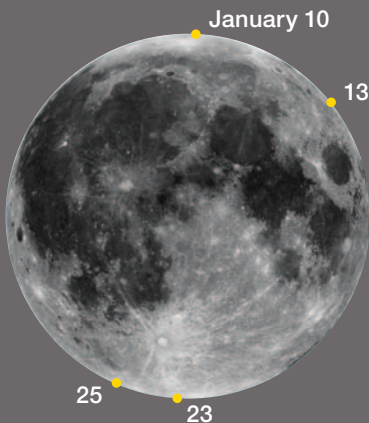


The Moon • January 2017
